Grand Alaska Cruise Tour - Norwegian Jewel

Day 1: Depart Home - Arrive Fairbanks

Transfer to the airport for your flight to **Fairbanks**. Upon arrival meet your Tour Director and transfer to your hotel for a two night stay.

Overnight: Fairbanks

Day 2: Fairbanks

Today enjoy a **Fairbanks City Tour** featuring the **Trans-Alaska Pipeline** and downtown district. Cruise on the Chena River aboard the **Discovery Stern-wheeler** and experience the time when traditional riverboats plied the waterways of Alaska's interior during the late 1800's. This evening enjoy dinner at the **Alaska Salmon Bake** located at historic Pioneer Park.

Meals - (B,D) Overnight: Fairbanks

Day 3: Fairbanks - Denali

Today motorcoach south to **Denali National Park**. Visit the river community of **Nenana** and the historic rail station. Arrive in Denali and visit the working **Husky Homestead Kennels**, owned by four-time Iditarod champion Jeff King. Learn insight into dog mushing and hear tales of this unique lifestyle. Enjoy an evening of exploring this pristine area at your leisure. Optional tours will be offered such as rafting or flightseeing.

Meals - (B) Overnight: Denali

Day 4: Denali National Park

Early this morning travel deep into **Denali National Park** on the **Tundra Wilderness Tour** and search the pristine wilderness for bear, moose, caribou, and Dall sheep. This six to eight hour journey is narrated allowing for insight into the animals, flora and fauna of this spectacular region. A snack is provided on tour. This evening enjoy a night of fun, festivity and food at the **Denali Dinner Theater**.

Meals - (B,SL,D) Overnight: Denali

Day 5: Denali - Talkeetna - Dome Railcar - Anchorage

This morning is at leisure for optional tours or to explore on your own. Later this morning depart Denali by motorcoach and travel south to the quaint town of **Talkeetna**. Enjoy time to explore this off-beat Alaskan community. Later transfer to the Talkeetna Rail Depot and board a **Deluxe Dome Railcar** for a scenic train ride south to **Anchorage**. Enjoy dinner on the train, arrive into Anchorage and transfer to your hotel for a one-night stay.

Meals - (B,D) Overnight: Anchorage

Day 6: Anchorage - Girdwood

Enjoy a brief **City Tour of Anchorage** including the **Historic Downtown Area, Lake Hood** where over 190 floatplanes take off and land daily, and **Earthquake Park** to learn about the 1964 Earthquake. Later enjoy a visit to the **Alaska Native Heritage Center**, a gathering place that celebrates and shares Alaska Native cultures. Later travel south along the Scenic Seward Byway to the resort community of **Girdwood** for a one-night stay. The afternoon is at leisure. This evening enjoy dinner with your fellow travelers.

Meals - (B,D) Overnight: Girdwood

Day 7: Girdwood - Seward/Board Ship

This morning is at leisure to explore on your own. Later visit the **Alaska Wildlife Conservation Center** where you will have a chance to see Alaska's wildlife up close. Then continue to historic Seward to begin your 7-night cruise aboard the elegant **Norwegian Jewel**. Onboard amenities include a Las Vegas style casino, movie theatre, pools and a library. While onboard, enjoy breakfast, lunch and fine dinners daily, as well as nightly entertainment in the Theater.

Reservation Information & Notes (Ocean Cruise)

PREMIER'S TRAVEL PROTECTION PLAN (TPP) - \$535 per person

The Pre-Departure Cancellation Fee Waiver (Part A - I & II) is provided by Premier World Discovery (PWD) and is not an insurance benefit. The Post Departure Travel Insurance Plan (Part B) is provided by USI Affinity Travel Insurance Services (USI).

Part A - Cancellation Waiver provided by PWD

I. Trip Cancellation Waiver (TCW) - Guarantees full refund on all payments, except the TPP Fee itself in case of cancellation up to the time and date of departure due to the passenger's personal illness or death of a member of the immediate family; or, if the passenger must return early due to the passenger's personal illness or death of a member of the immediate family, a refund for the unused land services. Medical/official documentation required.

II. Premier "Any Reason" Cancellation Waiver (ARCW) - Reimburses 75% of the cancellation fees in the form of a future travel credit certificate (FTCC) valid for 1 year, if you cancel more than 48 hours prior to scheduled departure for any reason not eligible for cash refund under the TCW (Part A - I.). FTCC is non-transferable, may not be redeemed for cash and does not include any credit for the TPP Fee. The TPP Fee (if chosen) is refundable until 180 days prior to departure & cannot be added after Final Payment. The TPP does not cover any single supplement charges due to an individual's traveling companion cancelling prior to departure. The TPP is non-transferable and valid for each applicant only. The TPP does not cover any services such as airline tickets not purchased through PWD. Cancellations, Claims & Inquiries under Part A will be administered by PWD. Certain Exclusions and Restrictions apply.

Part B - Post Departure Travel Insurance Plan provided by USI

Day 8: Cruising - Hubbard Glacier

This "Galloping Glacier" made history in 1986 when it surged forward at a rate of up to 130 feet a day, blocking off Russell Fjord. The ice dam was eventually broken, but Hubbard Glacier continues to surge forward, carving icebergs into the water. Keep your binoculars handy as you cruise through the glacier's home waters--the wildlife-rich Yakutat Bay.

Meals - (B,L,D) Overnight: Norwegian Jewel

Day 9: Cruising - Icy Strait Point - Whale Watching Tour

If it's tranquility and nature you seek, Icy Strait Point is your destination. It's also where you will begin a **Whale Watching Tour** to Point Adolphus, one of Alaska's premier humpback whale watching destinations. You'll travel through waters that support a wide array of marine life including orca, Steller's sea lions, seal, Dall's porpoise and of course the magnificent humpback whale.

Meals - (B,L,D) Overnight: Norwegian Jewel

Day 10: Cruising - Juneau - Sawyer Glacier

Today the ship arrives in Alaska's capital, Juneau, nestled between mountains and sea with a rustic charm that's both cosmopolitan & frontier. Maybe visit the Alaska State Museum to see a native clan house and a birch-bark canoe, gold rush memorabilia and Russian Orthodox relics. A short drive out of Juneau takes you to the impressive Mendenhall Glacier. Prepare to experience all the beauty and majesty of the Alaskan wilderness. Travel through Tracy Arm Fjord and witness the awe-inspiring beauty of Sawyer Glacier.

Meals - (B,L,D) Overnight: Norwegian Jewel

Day 11: Cruising - Skagway

The frontier spirit is alive and well in the gold-rush town of Skagway, the northernmost point of Alaska's Inside Passage. Relive the city's past in lively saloons, rousing dance hall revues and on vintage street car tours. Maybe board the historic White Pass & Yukon Railway or take the Klondike Summit drive to pan for gold.

Meals - (B,L,D) Overnight: Norwegian Jewel

Day 12: Cruising - Ketchikan

Today visit Ketchikan, "Salmon Capital of the World" and ancestral home of the Tlingit Indians. The rustic waterfront village has the world's largest collection of totem poles. Maybe learn the meaning behind totem pole imagery at the Saxman Native Village.

Meals - (B,L,D) Overnight: Norwegian Jewel

Day 13: Cruising - Inside Passage

Threading along the scenic coast of Canada and Alaska, the Inside Passage offers spectacular close-up views of rain forests, sparkling glaciers, steep-walled fjords and snow-capped mountains. Watch closely for whale, sea lion, bear and other wildlife as the Inside Passage is home to more than 100 species of animals.

Meals - (B,L,D) Overnight: Norwegian Jewel

Day 14: Vancouver, B.C. - Depart for home

This morning disembark and transfer to the Vancouver or Seattle, WA* airport for your flight home filled with fond memories of your **Grand Alaska Cruisetour**.
