Day 1 - February 6: Arrive Honolulu

Later see the State Capitol, the Governor's Mansion and drive through China Town and view King Kamehameha's statue before returning to your Honolulu area hotel.

Day 3 - February 8: Honolulu

Today enjoy a day at your leisure in paradise to soak up some sun on the beach, do some shopping or join an Optional Oahu Circle Island Tour.

Day 4 - February 9: Honolulu - Fly to Hilo (Big Island)

This morning fly to Hilo on the Island of Hawaii (the Big Island). Ascend the rugged countryside to Volcanoes National Park, a UNESCO World Heritage site where you'll see a real, smoking and steaming volcano as you look out across the Kilauea Caldera within which lies the Halemaumau Crater. Also visit the Jaggar Museum & Visitor Center to learn all about the geology and history of the volcano. Next make a short stop to take a walk through Thurston's Lava Tube. Then depart to see the unique Punaluu Black Sand Volcanic Beach. Later journey to the Kona Coast area and check into your resort for a 3-night stay. Enjoy the evening at leisure.

Day 5 - February 10: Kona Sightseeing

Today enjoy a full day Big Island Adventure, Visit Waipio Valley, Hamakua Coast & three stunning Big Island waterfalls - Hiilawe Falls, Akaka Falls and Rainbow Falls. This afternoon enjoy the Kona area featuring a visit to the Kona Coffee Company and Hawaiian Chocolate Factory. There will also be time to enjoy some shopping and exploring in Kailua Kona downtown, referred to by the locals as Kona or Kona town. Then enjoy dinner in Kona at a popular restaurant including a couple of special local brews---a draft from the Kona Brewing Company and an authentic cup of Kona Coffee.

Enjoy the magnificent views of the volcano's moonlike crater. From the top of Haleakala, depart to O'o Farms and enjoy a guided tour to learn about natural farming and participate in the harvesting. Enjoy a picnic lunch created from the bounty of your harvest combined with fresh caught local fish of the day. Continuing along the slopes of Haleakala visit Ali'i Kula Lavender Farm which has 45 varieties of plants blooming on 10.5 acres.

Day 9 - February 14: Maui - Snorkel & Whale Watch Cruise

Today enjoy a Snorkel & Whale Watch Cruise. Each year, from late December through mid-April, Humpback whales migrating from the arctic waters of Alaska to the warm waters of Hawaii. This evening join your fellow travelers for your Farewell Dinner at a traditional Hawaiian Luau, a fun cultural event featuring local food, dancing and music.
