## SAFETY TIPS FOR SMART ONLINE BANKING

#### **AVOID SHARED COMPUTERS AND NETWORKS**

If you're banking on a shared computer, you're putting your account at risk. This includes Internet cafés as well as your computer at work.

When you're finished using GNB's Online Banking, logout. If you do not logout, you run the risk of somebody else gaining access to your account.

Tapping into outside Wi-Fi networks is also dangerous. Please be cautious when using Wi-Fi networks in airports, cafés, trains or taxi cabs, with some exceptions. If you're given a password to get onto a wireless network, it is safer. At hotels, opting for a wired connection is safest.

#### PROTECT YOUR PASSWORD

With online banking, good security hinges on a rock-solid password. But many passwords are easily hacked. We advise using a difficult password with a three-, four- or five-word phrase followed by a number and a symbol, such as an exclamation point.

Never write your password down and don't ask your computer to remember your password.

Our Online Banking Agreement can be found on the website for easy reference. It is a guide to your Online Banking responsibility as well as the bank's responsibility.
