Day 1: Depart Home - Portland

Today arrive in **Portland, Oregon**, "City of Roses". Meet your Tour Director and enjoy a Portland City Tour to see the Columbia River, Washington Park with its famous International Rose Test Garden, Pioneer Courthouse Square and the famous downtown food trucks. Learn how Portland has transformed from a small lumber town into a bustling big city with a lively downtown. Later check into your hotel in the Portland area for two-night stay. Tonight enjoy a Welcome Dinner with your fellow GO Club travelers. Overnight: Portland Area Meal - (D)

Day 2: Portland - Multnomah Falls - Columbia River Gorge Cruise

This morning travel east and stop at Multnomah Falls, the second highest year-round waterfall in the nation. Then experience the history of the Columbia River Gorge and learn about the Lewis and Clark Expedition on a cruise aboard the Sternwheeler Columbia Gorge, an authentic triple-deck paddle wheeler, providing breathtaking views. Also see the **Bonneville Dam**, part of a dam system which produces power and creates a 465-mile navigable waterway. Later return to Portland and enjoy the evening at leisure. Meal - (B) Overnight: Portland Area

Day 3: Portland - Newport - Oregon Dunes - Coos Bay

This morning travel through the fertile Willamette Valley, containing beautiful vineyards and home to much of Oregon's agriculture. Next visit the historic coastal town of Newport, founded in 1866. Continue and explore the magnificent Oregon Coast and visit the Oregon Dunes National Recreation Area, a unique 40 mile stretch of windswept sand which is the largest expanse of coastal sand dunes in North America with dunes towering up to 500 feet. Experience an exciting **Dune Buggy Tour** on the 250-foot tall sand dunes. Continue to Coos Bay and enjoy your evening at leisure.

Meal - (B) Overnight: Coos Bay

Day 4: Coos Bay - Rogue River Jetboat - Redwoods National Park - Eureka Early this morning travel south along the Oregon Coast to Gold Beach & board your vessel for a Rogue River Jetboat Trip. The half day scenic adventure features wildlife and pristine wilderness along the 'Historic Mail Boat route' to the small town of Agness where you will stop for an included lunch. This afternoon your motorcoach ventures into California. Stop to visit famous **Redwood National Park**, home to the majestic coast redwood trees, the world's tallest living things which can grow to 350 feet. Late afternoon arrive in Eureka and drive through Old Town to view several of the famous & beautiful Victorian Homes. Tonight enjoy dinner with your fellow travelers at a popular local restaurant.

Overnight: Eureka Meals - (B,L,D)

Day 5: Eureka - Avenue of the Giants - Mendocino Winery - Sacramento This morning depart for the **Avenue of the Giants**. This world-famous scenic drive is a 31-mile portion of old Highway 101 with 51,000+ acres of redwood groves. The Avenue of the Giants is surrounded by Humboldt Redwoods State Park which has the largest remaining stand of virgin redwoods in the world. Later travel into Mendocino County, home to one of California's great

wine regions. Stop for a Mendocino Winery Tour & Tasting experience to sample the local product and learn about wine making. Continue south and travel to California's capital city, Sacramento, for a one-night stay.

Overnight: Sacramento Meal - (B)

Day 6: Sacramento - Yosemite National Park

Today journey inland through the fertile San Joaquin Valley, known as the breadbasket of California & stop at a Fruit Stand in the fertile Central Valley. Later climb the scenic foothills of the Sierra Nevada Mountains & arrive at your overnight accommodations near Yosemite National Park for a two-night stay. Enjoy dinner this evening with your fellow travelers.

Meals - (B,D) Overnight: Yosemite Area

Day 7: Yosemite National Park

Spend the day touring & visiting Yosemite National Park, one of the America's greatest natural wonders. Enter the spectacular Yosemite Valley and enjoy a guided tram tour to view the giant iconic formations of El Capitan & Half Dome and breathtaking Yosemite Falls, the highest in North America. Return to Yosemite Village where you have time for lunch and enjoy free time to take in the immense beauty of this spectacular and historic national park. This evening enjoy dinner with your fellow travelers.

Day 8: Yosemite National Park - San Francisco

Today cross the majestic Golden Gate Bridge into one of the world's most beautiful cities, San Francisco.
