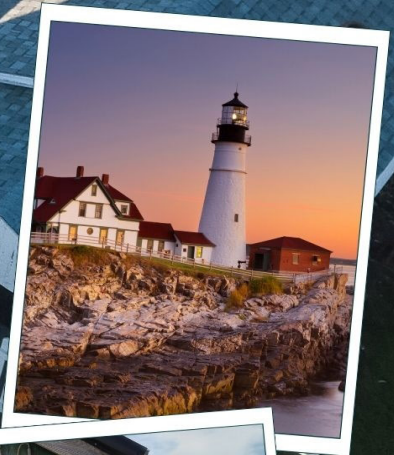

Tuesday, September 28, Day 4

Step into Maine's rich seafaring past with a guided tour of the seaside city of Portland! Known as one of the most influential American poets of the 19th century, we'll see Henry Longfellow's boyhood home, as well as sea captain's houses, and a stop at Portland Head Lighthouse, the most photographed lighthouse in the U.S. Enjoy free time at the historic Portland waterfront - home to unique shops and eateries. Next, we'll tour Victoria Mansion, an elegant historic home featuring spectacular architecture, stunning interiors, and exquisite, original furnishings. This evening, we'll enjoy dinner with entertainment.

Wednesday, September 29, Day 5

Today starts at the Maine Maritime Museum, beautifully situated along the scenic Kennebec River in Bath - famously known as "The City of Ships". Here, the stories of Maine's waterways come alive, weaving together centuries of maritime heritage, innovation, and adventure. Wander through fascinating exhibits before exploring the historic Percy & Small Shipyard, the only surviving shipyard in America where massive wooden sailing vessels were once crafted by hand.

The journey continues at Boothbay Railway Village, where history rolls, whistles, and steams its way into your imagination. Stroll among 28 historic buildings, climb aboard a charming Narrow Gauge Steam Train, and discover treasures from another era — from gleaming antique automobiles to an extraordinary model railroad display and authentic vintage boxcars. Around every corner awaits a new glimpse into the ingenuity and spirit of New England's past.

Thursday, September 30, Day 6

Today's guided adventure leads us to the charming coastal villages of Kennebunk and Kennebunkport, where classic New England beauty meets the rugged Atlantic shoreline. Stroll through the lively Dock Square in Kennebunkport before following scenic Ocean Avenue, with sweeping ocean vistas around every turn. Along the way, we'll pass the famous Walker's Point estate, summer home of George H. W. Bush, perched dramatically along the coast, and admire the picturesque beaches of Kennebunk.



Our day continues with a visit to the beautiful gardens and shrines of the Franciscan Monastery. During free time, enjoy browsing the unique boutiques, galleries, and inviting eateries that make downtown Kennebunkport so beloved. Next, step aboard history at the Seashore Trolley Museum, where a ride through the countryside aboard a lovingly restored streetcar offers a nostalgic glimpse into another era. Tonight, savor one of Maine's most iconic traditions - a classic lobster dinner, the perfect ending to our day!
