Wednesday, June 8 - Day 5

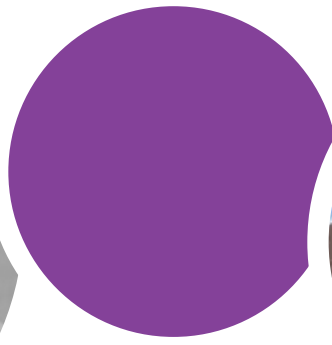
