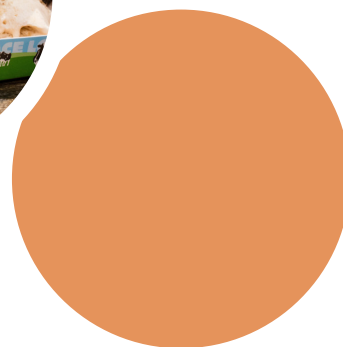

Wednesday, October 11 - Day 5

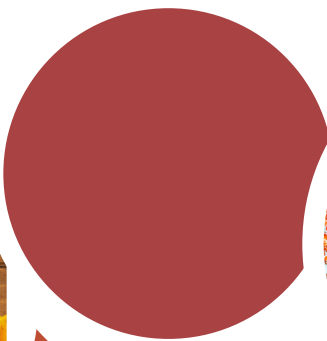
